Euromediterranean Master in Interreligious Dialogue and Tourism

The E.M.I.D.T. Master's Degree (*Euromediterranean Master in Interreligious Dialogue and Tourism*) aims to provide students with the necessary knowledge to take decisions related to the management of religious tourism, culture & heritage activities in the Mediterranean area.

The Master's Degree courses are open to anybody with a recognised university qualification (non-Italian nationals may need a "dichiarazione di valore" from an Italian Embassy). The E.M.I.D.T. Study programme is based on the *United Nation World Tourism Organization* (U.N.W.T.O.) with U.N.E.S.C.O. principles, and follows the *Academic Network on Interreligious Multicultural Approach* (A.N.I.M.A). Special emphasis will be given to topics related to the Euro-Mediterranean region.

The E.M.I.D.T. Master is promoted by the *Community of Mediterranean Universities* (CMU), the *Jean Monnet Euromediterranean Center of Excellence*, *The University of the Salento* and *EMUNI University*.

The aim of the Master is to overcome boundaries and differences; to build mutual understanding among Euro-Mediterranean countries; to create an academic partnership of higher education and research institutions, and to develop a network of specialized postgraduate study programmes for those working and studying in intercultural and interreligious fields.

International credit comparability and the 2nd Level Master degree qualification itself are recognized by the EU Higher Education rules.

This Master's Course adheres to the priorities outlined by the European Commission and by the *Jean Monnet Programme* on intercultural and interreligious dialogue. The course also closely follows the I.D.E.A. research project, which values 'Multilingualism' and 'Information Communication and Technology' (ICT) as key factors in improving mutual understanding and in creating pan-Euro-Mediterranean values and beliefs.

The dissertation will be a research or professional assignment related to one of the programme's course modules, and will be assessed on the student's ability to demonstrate particular knowledge or skills.

Courses will be taught in English and Russian. Optionally, some subjects may be taught also in Italian. and French.

Structure : **800 hours** of lectures with students (10/15 ECTS will be delivered in Slovenia);

200 hours of alternative lectures (on-line)

1.250 hours of individual research;

750 hours of stage + study for final thesis

Total of **3.000 hours** corresponding to the total of **60 ECTS**
